Foreword



Welcome to Zurich !

Although not officially the capital and government headquarters, Zurich is the cultural, financial and tourist center of Swiss. Having a tram as a vehicle in OMSI2 program, now you have the opportunity to drive through the mere center of Zurich and enjoy the classical, intact and divine architecture of this unique worldwide famous city. Driving a bus through the center, though, is not allowed.

The tram route 11, 13km long with 34 stops, takes you from rural suburbs of Auzelg all the way to the city center and then uphill to green Rehalp. First, you get to see modern business facilities along Thurgauerstrasse Street, the City Stadium, the Tram Depot and Oerlikon Railway Station where StadlerGiruno, the newest gem of Swiss railway industry, is located. It is placed on platform 3, but when passing through, also on platforms 1 and 2. If you want to drive it, this train is also available in Train Simulator version as a separate product. (visit download shop - link).



Moving forward to Rahalp, next to Radio Studio stop, there is a new-bulit Guggach3 complex which was finished at about the same time as OMSI2 Zurich11. The next stop is Bucheggplatz, whose footbridges overshadowing the whole square like a giant spider make it one of a kind. After Schaffhauserplatz stop, the route starts its descent towards the center and after crossing the Limmat river over Walchebrucke bridge, you enter downtown. You pass by the Landesmuseum, then classical, recently restored Zurich HB headquarters building and you enter Bahnhofstrasse Street, in which only trams and pedestrians are allowed. To own a store here, even for only a short period of time, is a matter of prestige, not only for those in fashion industry, but for everybody else. Cartier, Rolex, Prada, Louis Viton, just to name a few, are some of the famous names you will be able to find in this street.



Some of the biggest Swiss bankshave their branchesat Paradeplatz square. Drive carefully, there are a lot of pedestrians. After this remarkable street, you pass by Burkliplatz square on the north side of the Zurich Lake. You cross over Quaibrücke bridge and enter Bellevue square where there are the Corso, a unique old-fashioned cinema-theatre, and monumental Zurich Opera House. Stadelhofen, a small, but important railway station, is nearby. After that, our route leaves downtown and starts its ascent at Forchstrasse Street towards Rehalp. You pass by Kreuzplatz and Hegibachplatz squares, Tram Museum and Balgrist University Hospital. If you obey traffic rules, it will take you 45 minutes from Auzelg, the first stop, to Rehalp, the last stop.

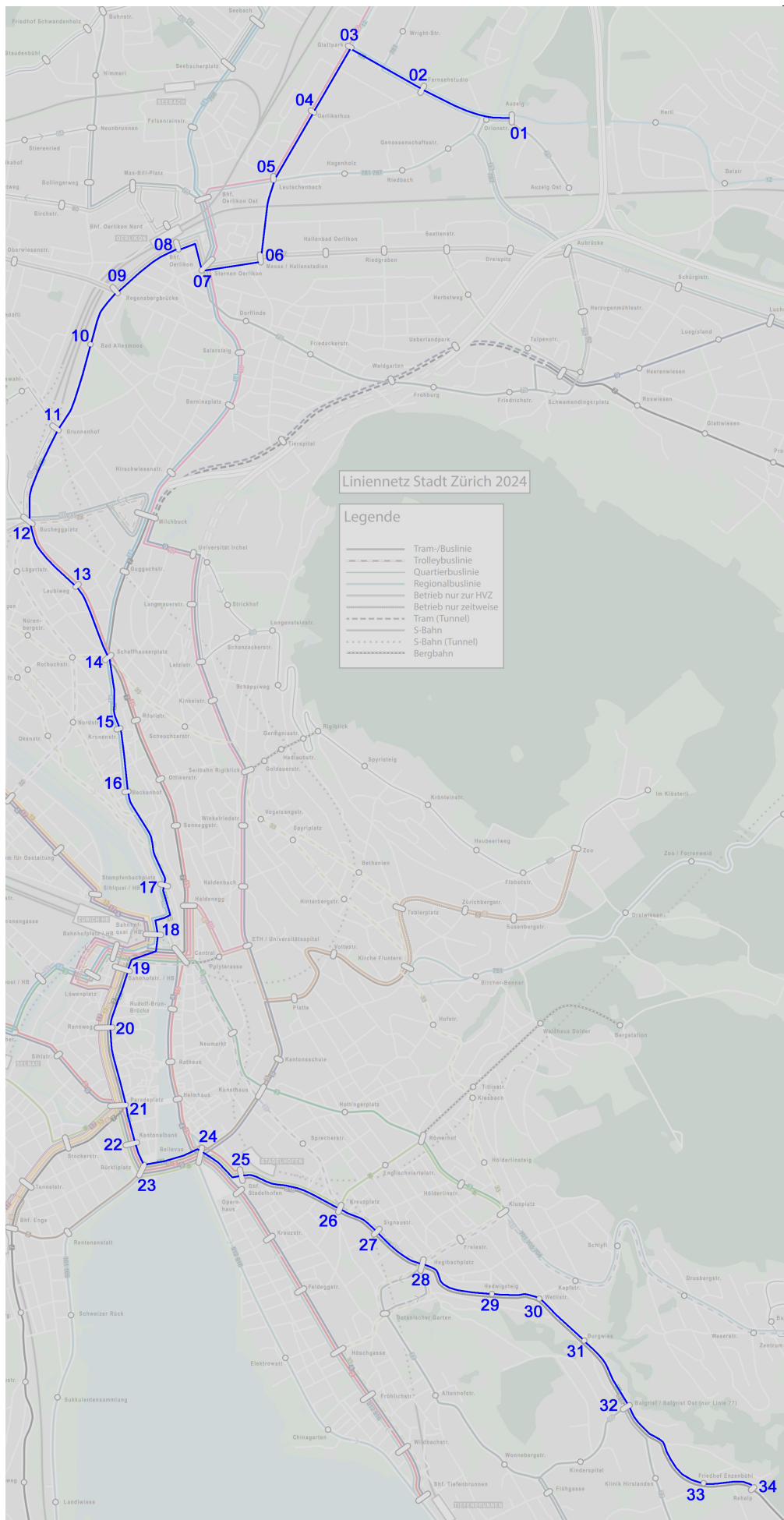
